



# Zello

Zello is an added feature GMRS Live has made available. To use this feature you must be registered. Many users and HUBs or groups use Zello. At the time of this writing GMRS Live has one Zello channel and it is connected to the 700 HUB. Anyone can add the Zello channel and listen in. Only 'trusted' users can transmit. Licensed GMRS users can request access to transmit by going to the GMRS Live website and filling in the request form. Once approved you will receive an email with an access pin number. Calling for a moderator (on the Zello channel) and supplying your pin number will get you trusted in allowing you to transmit. Note that with this being a hobby that admins or moderators may or may not be online. If you can not contact one you can call out with your call sign and pin number. If a moderator comes online they can check back in the history and hear your request and they will 'trust' you in from this message. You must leave your Zello online (can be on solo or busy) for this to work. This Zello channel is connected to Nodes that are linked to RF radios and repeaters. Please make sure when transmitting you use all FCC rules and regulations.

The Zello Channel is...

GMRS LIVE NODE1

Do a search for that name. If you are asked for a password you are on the wrong channel. This search is not case sensitive. You can also scan the QR Code from within the app to add the channel



Note: The only way to get trusted in to use Zello on the GMRS Live Network is by filling in the request form.
